Membership of ANATS implies the member's ongoing commitment to:

- Professional and ethical conduct.
- Competence, honesty and integrity in all dealings with students, ANATS colleagues and other members of the singing and allied professions.
- Civil and respectful communication with students, ANATS colleagues and other members of the singing and allied profession.
- Truth and avoidance of ambiguity in statements of qualifications.
- Realistic appraisal of a student's career prospects as a singer (when requested).
- Avoid careless or malicious injury, whether directly or indirectly, to the reputation, prospects or business of other ANATS members and the broader community.
- Refrain from intentionally influencing the students of other teachers.
- Actively develop skills and vocational knowledge in the pursuit of professional and pedagogical excellence.
