- A letter of application detailing rationale for that candidate's merit in being awarded the scholarship, along with a budget showing how the money would be spent (up to 1000 words).
- A video recording of the applicant singing two contrasting songs or song excerpts. The recording can be sent as a video file, uploaded on YouTube and the link provided, or sent on a DVD.

The purpose of this recording is solely to get an impression of the applicant; there is no expectation of a polished performance.

- Applications will be viewed by a panel of three, comprising two members of the Victorian Chapter committee of ANATS Ltd and one independent industry professional who is not necessarily a member of ANATS Ltd.
- The criteria on which the selection rests are:
 - o The applicant's musicality and expressivity evident in his/her performance.
 - The merit of the applicant's argument in outlining their circumstances and expectations.
 - The viability and merit of the study plans outlined by the applicant.
- All applicants will be notified of the outcome within four weeks of the closing date of applications.
- The successful recipient must submit an acquittal detailing how the money has been spent within 12 months of award of the scholarship
